

"How to Interpret Your Dreams"

Tonight's Class Objective:

Impart & stir the gift of prophetic dreams and train our interns to interpret them.

Introduction:

Did you know that an anointed prophetic person can pray over you and impart supernatural gifts? We will anoint you for prophetic dreams tonight! You will begin to have more prophetic dreams.

1 Timothy 4:14

Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy...

1. Who Receives Prophetic Dreams?

Prophetic dreams occur many times in the Bible and are experienced by all sorts of people, including prophets (Daniel



7:1), ungodly kings (Daniel 2), and average men (Genesis 31:24).

2. Dreams Do Not Always Require Interpretation

Sometimes the dreams required interpretation, as with Nebuchadnezzar's dream in Daniel 2. Other times, no interpretation was necessary as God spoke clearly to the dreamer, as in the story of Abimelech and Abraham's wife (Genesis 20:1–6).

3. The Definition of a Prophetic Dream

The definition of a prophetic dream might be something like this: a supernatural night vision that contains foresight, instruction or direction.

4. Be Careful to Give God Praise

Daniel was careful to give praise to God, who alone gives the wisdom to interpret such dreams (Daniel 2:20–23).



5. Is This Dream from God?

If you think you have had a prophetic dream or have heard a firsthand story from another person who has had a prophetic dream, the first question to ask is "is this dream from God?"

Compare the content of the dream and its message to the Scriptures; if anything seems to contradict God's words or His nature, it is wise to disregard the dream—even if it comes true.

God will never go against His Word. The Bible is our standard for truth and the revelation that God has given. We can always ask God for wisdom (James 1:5) when examining a dream.

6. Not All Details in The Dream Are Relevant

Most dreams only contain a few details that are relevant. We eat the meat and spit out the bones.



7. God Speaks Through Symbols

Many books are written that help us learn the prophetic language of heaven. We also learn the symbolic language of God by walking with those who are more seasoned than we are.

We must learn God's prophetic symbology to make sense of this amazing supernatural gift that is as ancient as God Himself!
