Introduction

Luke 7

5 And the apostles said to the Lord, **“Increase our faith.”** 6 So the Lord said, “If you have faith as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you.

My 1st Point

Is Everyone Called To Work Miracles?

Yes and no. In the following Scripture we see Paul explaining to

the Corinth church that not everyone operates on the same level of miracle working power. Then he turns around and says seek after the “best” gifts after he listed the order of their importance. Many people never climb higher because they never press higher into the “best” gifts!

1 Corinthians 12

28 And God has appointed these in the church: **first** apostles, **second** prophets, **third** teachers, **after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations**, varieties of tongues.

29 Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles? 30 Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? 31 But **earnestly desire the best gifts.**

I believe God is saying don’t get stuck at the helps & administration level! Let’s go higher!

9 of 27 Recorded Miracles of Jesus in Matthew

1. Jesus heals the fever of Peter’s mother-in-law

Matthew 8:14-15 NKJV:

Now when **Jesus had come into Peter’s house**, He saw his wife’s mother **lying sick with a fever**. So **He touched her hand**, and **the fever left her**. And she arose and served them.

Let’s remember to pray for fevers, headaches and other common illnesses that seem minor. These lead to major miracles. Practice makes perfect.

2. Jesus heals many sick and oppressed in Capernaum

Matthew 8:16-17 NKJV:

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And **He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick**, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:

“He Himself took our infirmities
And bore our sicknesses.”

3. Jesus heals the sick and demon-possessed

Matthew 4:23-25 NKJV:

And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and **they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics**; and He healed them. **Great multitudes followed Him**—from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.

I have a vision for this online church. That we would train multitudes of healing & deliverance ministers; and that our anointing will attract the sick to us and we will heal them in droves!

4. Jesus cleanses a man with leprosy

Matthew 8:1-4 NKJV:

When He had come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed Him. And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying, “Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.” Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, “I am willing; be cleansed.” Immediately his leprosy was cleansed. And Jesus said to him, “See that you tell no one; but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.”

5. Jesus heals a paralytic let down through a roof

Matthew 9:1-8 NKJV:

So He got into a boat, crossed over, and came to His own city. Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son, be of good cheer; **your sins are forgiven you.**”

And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, **“This Man blasphemes!”** But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, **“Why do you think evil in your hearts?”**

For which is easier, to say, ‘Your sins are forgiven you,’ or to say, ‘Arise and walk’? **But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins”**—then He said to the paralytic, **“Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.”**

And he arose and departed to his house. **Now when the multitudes saw it, they marveled and glorified God, who had given such power to men.**

6. Jesus heals a man’s withered hand on the Sabbath

Matthew 12:9-14 NKJV:

Now when He had departed from there, He went into their synagogue. And behold, there was a man who had a withered hand. And they asked Him, saying, “Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?”—that they might accuse Him.

Then He said to them, **“What man is there among you who has**

one sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will not lay hold of it and lift it out? Of how much more value then is a man than a sheep?

Therefore it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath.” Then He said to the man, “Stretch out your hand.” And he stretched it out, and it was restored as whole as the other. **Then the Pharisees went out and plotted against Him, how they might destroy Him.**

7. Jesus heals a great multitude of people

Matthew 12:15 NKJV:

But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.

8. Jesus heals a centurion’s slave in Capernaum

Matthew 8:5-13 NKJV:

Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him, saying, “Lord, my servant is lying at

home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented.” And Jesus said to him, “I will come and heal him.” The centurion answered and said, “Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof.

But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, ‘Go,’ and he goes; and to another, ‘Come,’ and he comes; and to my servant, ‘Do this,’ and he does it.”

When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, “Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel! And I say to you that many will come from east and west, and sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. But the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.” Then Jesus said to the centurion, “Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you.” And his servant was healed that same hour.

9. Jesus heals a blind, mute, demon-possessed man

Matthew 12:22-23 NKJV:

Then one was brought to Him who was **demon-possessed, blind and mute; and He healed him**, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw. And all **the multitudes were amazed** and said, “Could this be the Son of David?”
